Solitary Bees are typically stingless and excellent pollinators. Since females can't depend on a hive for nesting, they must build one from hollow logs. Solitary bee populations are in serious decline and desperately need our help!



Ladybugs are cute, happy and friendly beetles that spend the winter sleeping in woodchips. By the spring and summer, they are ready to enter the garden and eat aphids!



Lacewings are welcomed in the garden because of their voracious appetite for plant-eating pests. They nest between pieces of wood and devour aphids, leafhoppers, whiteflies, mites and caterpillars.



Butterflies are important pollinators that love the color red! They slip through the slits to hibernate from winter until spring, when they are warm enough to fly again.



Earwigs are beneficial protectors of fruit trees and vegetable gardens. They are principally nocturnal animals with a taste for aphids and plant lice.
